ABOUT PROFESSOR RAMESH TRIPATHI

Professor Tripathi is an Associate Professor of Surgery at the University of Queensland, Brisbane, and an Adjunct Professor at the University of the Sunshine Coast. He earned his MBBS from JIPMER, India, his FRCS in General Surgery from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, an Aortic Fellowship from the University of Cologne, Germany, and his FRACS in Vascular Surgery from the Australasian College of Surgeons.

He is a Distinguished Fellow of the Society for Vascular Surgery (SVS), the American Venous Forum (AVF), and the Vascular Society of India. He has received numerous accolades, including the Honorary Membership and Distinguished Invitational Lecturer of the European Venous Forum (2018), the Asterios Katsamouris Lecture by the European Society for Cardiovascular Surgery (2017), the Egas Moniz Medal from the University of Lisbon (2015), and the Prof HT Vira Reddi Oration from the Vascular Society of India (2023).

Professor Tripathi has held visiting professorships at Stanford University, Mayo Clinic, Karolinska University Hospitals, the University of Lisbon, the University of Cologne, and the University of British Columbia. He has published over 90 peer-reviewed articles, authored 17 textbook chapters, and edited 3 books. He has delivered over 230 invited lectures at international conferences.

He performed India's first Endovascular Repair of Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (EVAR) and Thoracic Endovascular Aneurysm Repair (TEVAR) in 1998. He also pioneered the first Talent on Xcelent TEVAR device in Australia and New Zealand in 2005 and has invented two techniques for deep vein valve repair since 1997.

As the Founder Editor-in-Chief of the Indian Journal of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery, Professor Tripathi has served as an associate editor and international guest editor for several prestigious journals. He is a distinguished reviewer and sits on the editorial boards of numerous journals.

Professor Tripathi dedicates time annually to pro-bono surgical work for the underprivileged in India. In Australia, he leads the Venous Ulcer Foundation, helping to heal venous ulcers worldwide.
